RECEIVER'S UNOPPOSED MOTION TO ALLOW INITIAL PAYMENTS BY RECEIVER RELATED TO EMPLOYEE WAGES

Receiver W. Craig Stokley ("Receiver") files this Unopposed Motion to Allow Initial Payments by Receiver Related to Employee Wages and, in support, would respectfully show the Court as follows:

- 1. On February 14, 2017, the Securities and Exchange commission ("SEC") initiated these proceedings and sought the appoint of a receiver. On that same day, the Court issued its Order Appointing Receiver, by which W. Craig Stokley was appointed Receiver. Paragraph 7 of the Order provides the powers of the Receiver to make payments contemplated by this Motion.
- 2. Specifically, payroll was processed on February 14, 2017, the same day that the Order Appointing Receiver was entered. Paychex, Inc., the payroll company for Optimal Economics Capital Partners, LLC ("OE Capital") processed and paid payroll of OE Capital on that date. However, the Asset Freeze resulted in the payment to Paychex, Inc. being returned.

Therefore, Paychex, Inc. is entitled to payment for the amounts paid for payroll, and the taxes associated with payroll are due to be paid.

- 3. Further, based on the information the Receiver has obtained to date, certain employee wages have not been paid by OE Capital to interns of OE Capital who were not paid though payroll.
- 4. Accordingly, the Receiver requests authorization, pursuant to the Receiver's powers in Paragraph 7 of the Order Appointing Receiver, to make the following payments:
 - a. Wages in the amount of \$500.00, to each of the three interns of interns of Optimal Economics Capital Partners, LLC ("OE Capital")(in the total amount of \$1,500.00);
 - Reimbursement of amounts paid for employee payroll for the period of February 1,
 2017 through February 14, 2017, to Paychex, Inc., in the amount of \$38,237.62;
 - c. Payment of taxes related to the February 14, 2017 payroll, in the following amounts:
 - i. Federal unemployment in the amount of \$422.61;
 - ii. Florida State unemployment in the amount of \$427.32;
 - iii. Texas State unemployment in the amount of \$1,761.16; and
 - iv. Texas State surcharge in the amount of \$67.73;
- d. Any further wages or payroll or related expenses incurred, consistent with the powers of the Receiver in Paragraph 7 of the Order Appointing Receiver.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the Receiver requests that the Court enter the Unopposed Order Granting Receiver's Unopposed Motion to Allow Initial Payments by Receiver elated to Employee Wages and for such other and further relief to which the Receiver
