

Defendant Patrick Howard **shall** file a written brief showing cause why he should not be held in civil contempt of the court's order as alleged, documented, and requested by the Receiver in docket entry numbers 56-58, no later than **May 19, 2017**.


The Receiver **shall** arrange to have a process server personally serve this Order, along with the motion to show cause, brief, and appendix in support, on the non-party respondents Dovile Soblinskas, Christine Horne, and Ron Scherer, and file a notice with the Court containing an affidavit of service on each non-party respondent.

Each non-party Respondent (Dovile Soblinskas, Christine Horne, and Ron Scherer) who is personally served (or served through their counsel) **shall** file a written brief showing cause why they are not in contempt of the Court's order as alleged, and documented, by the Receiver in docket entry numbers 56-58, no later than **May 19, 2017, or 21 days** after receiving service, whichever is later.

The Receiver and/or the United States Securities and Exchange Commission may file a response/reply to Respondents submissions on or before **June 3, 2017, or 14 days** after the briefs are actually filed, whichever is later.

Further, should the Receiver become aware of any future conduct by Respondents, or any other former employee of the Receivership Entities, that he believes is a violation of the Order Appointing Receiver (including any Respondents involvement, directly or indirectly, in making any false or misleading statements to investors of the Receivership Entities), the Receiver shall file a notice detailing said violation with the court and explaining whether the violation should result in expedited relief.
